SEMI-ANNUAL CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING HELD AUGUST 2, 2014

The semi-annual church business meeting was called to order by Pas to r Jules E. Smith at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 2. After devotion, Pas tor Smith stated the purpose/objective of the meeting which was simply an update after the annual meeting in January and to discuss upcoming events/projects for the remainder of the year. Minutes of the previous meeting were adopted and approved.

The Trustee Ministry, under the leadership of Bro. Frank Boldoe, began with their presentation on the church website. Rebel Stafford of Lebertech, the website technology firm being used, discussed the website and how each ministry will be able to input their specific news announcements. Hopefully each ministry will participate to make the website an integral part of providing the community with news about Rising Star. worship services will again be streamed live and church announcements will be added to the website. The Christian Scroll Newsletter will also be part of the website. William Payne, Sis. Jennifer LaLande, Bro. Johnny Bland and Sis. Nina Myles are coordinators of the website project team.

The nominating committee for the recommendation of Trustee Ministry members for 2015 was selected followed by the 2014 mid-year financial report presented by Sis. Margie Legins. Bro. Jack Choice then gave an analysis of the 2014 year-to-date income and expense cash flow report.

Pastor Smith commented that "God is certainly turning things around" as he reported 2014 achievements and accomplishments. The church conducted a stewardship fund drive, held a Women

United Women's Day program for the first time in several years, implemented Thursday noon Bible Study, held Ordination Services for Rev. Reginald Taylor, enjoyed a Father's Day breakfast and Senior Steppers Tea, and repairs were made to parking lot outside the The Youth Ministry Fellowship Hall. enjoyed a youth retreat at Estes Park, held their annual Youth Revival and distributed over 100 school backpacks at the church The Events Team Ministry has cookout. successfully marketed the fellowship hall and gymnasium to the community whereby those venues are almost in constant use for worship services, weddings, family and sports events.

Upcoming events include the 51st Church Anniversary and Ministry Week beginning August 20 – August 24, the 28th Pastoral Anniversary October 9-12 and the Annual Fruit of the Spirit celebration on November 8.

Pastor Smith then spoke on "Building Healthy Churches To Serve an Unhealthy Society" (Ephesians 4:11-16). The underlying tone is that neither Rising Star nor any other church can continue business as usual or leadership as usual while the world calls our attention to the freedom of the individual as opposed to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

In Open Forum, needed church repairs were discussed as well as the continuing debate over two worship services vs one.

Pastor Smith thanked the church body for their support, prayers and faithfulness during these challenging times.

51st ANNIVERSARY MINISTRY WEEK/ WORSHIP SERVICES

Pastor Gregory D. Johnson of Greater Union Baptist Church, Denver, was the guest speaker on Wednesday evening, August 20, 2014. Pastor Johnson's topic was the same as Rising Star's theme, "God's Gonna Turn It Around, Isaiah 43:18-19. One thought I penned from his message is, "God is more interested in our now and future than our past!" Scriptures he referenced include Proverbs 28:13, Proverbs 24:10, Matthew 9:27.

On Thursday evening, Pastor Dwayne Moore of Ebenezer Baptist Church, Denver, spoke from Nehemiah 8:9-10, "Why Rising Star Ought to Celebrate".

Friday night's services were a musical celebration featuring the Rising Star Workshop Choir under the direction of Psalmist Brandon Garrett, Minister of Music at True Light Baptist Church in Denver, CO. Musicians from around the city participated along with the Rising Star Instruments of Praise dancers.







RECIPE OF THE MONTH

1-2-3 TUNA PIE

1 pie crust shell
6 ½ oz. can tuna (drained)
1 lb. mixed vegetables (drained) canned or frozen
10 ½ can cream of mushroom soup (undiluted)

Remove, set aside crust.

Combine tuna and soup, pour into pie tin.

Spread vegetables over tuna mixture.

Place crust on top of vegetables, slitting in several places. Do not seal edge.

Place on baking sheet and bake in 425° oven for 15-20 minutes.








YOUTH PAINT-A-THON




